Women in the Québec Francophone Comedy Industry: Ladies in "Old Boy's Club

ABSTRACT

Study of women in the cultural industry represents a timely opportunity for research considering the evolution in the gender work dynamic. Following the #meToo movement, the Québec Francophone comedy industry is a good context to study women occupying various roles in the "Old Boys' Club". The presentation will present a profile of the French-language humour industry ecosystem in Québec and present results of the 2 parts of a survey (Sociodemographics and equality Women & Men).
