#### Course Description/Instructor's Statement

An examination of accounting and reporting issues related primarily to liabilities and equity.

#### Instructor's Description:

This is the second of two Intermediate Accounting courses, which cover the traditional financial accounting topics as well as recent developments within the accounting profession. This course will focus on the liabilities and equity side of the balance sheet. In addition, we will cover several advanced topics in accounting.

#### Course Learning Objectives:

1. **Record** financial transactions in compliance with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) applicable to public companies in Canada.
2. **Record** financial transactions in compliance with the Accounting Standards for Private Enterprises (ASPE) applicable to private companies in Canada
3. **Analyze** the impact of the financial transactions on the financial statements
4. **Prepare** financial statements in compliance with IFRS and ASPE and **understand** their limitations
5. **Use** Excel basic functions for accounting purposes.
