<p>Year 4</p>		<p>BUSI 4601 - Business Ethics Prerequisites: 4th year standing BUSI 4609 - Strategic Management Prerequisites: 4th year standing; All 2000-level and 3000-level courses must be completed in the major. 1.0 credit in Business at the 4000-level (This can be satisfied using 1.0 at the 4000-level from the concentration courses.) (All 4000-level courses must be completed at Carleton University.)</p>
