Continued from Year 1. Above the level of FREN 2100, take FREN 2110, 2401, 3701, 3702, etc.

JAPA/CHIN: 3010 (0.5 cr. Fall); 3020 (0.5 cr. Winter)

Remaining Language credits to be completed in Year 3 while abroad to total 4.0 credits.
