

Minor in Business [4.0 credits]

This pamphlet is only a guide. Consult both your academic audit and the Carleton University Undergraduate Calendar (www.carleton.ca/cuuc) for specific rules that apply to your program.

Minor in Business: is an option designed for students registered in degree programs other than the Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of International Business. The minor can be earned through successful completion of 4.0 credits specified in the table. On successful completion of all requirements, the designation “Minor in Business” will be noted on the students transcript and diploma.

Eligibility for Minor in Business: Only students pursuing undergraduate programs (except B.Com and BIB) requiring at least 20.0 credits to graduate (Honours) and who have completed at least 4.0 credits (first year) towards their degree, with a minimum overall CGPA of 7.0, may be admitted to the Minor in Business.

and **0.5 credit in BUSI at the 2000-level**

2.0 credits in:

Prerequisites: 2nd year standing

BUSI 2204- Basic Marketing

BUSI 2400 - Foundations of Information Systems

BUSI 2503* - Basic Finance for Non-Business Majors
Prerequisites: 2nd year standing

Please Note:

If you plan on taking two Minors in Business, (e.g. the Minor in Business and the Minor in Entrepreneurship or the Minor in Arts Management), only 2.0 credits can double count between the two Minors.
